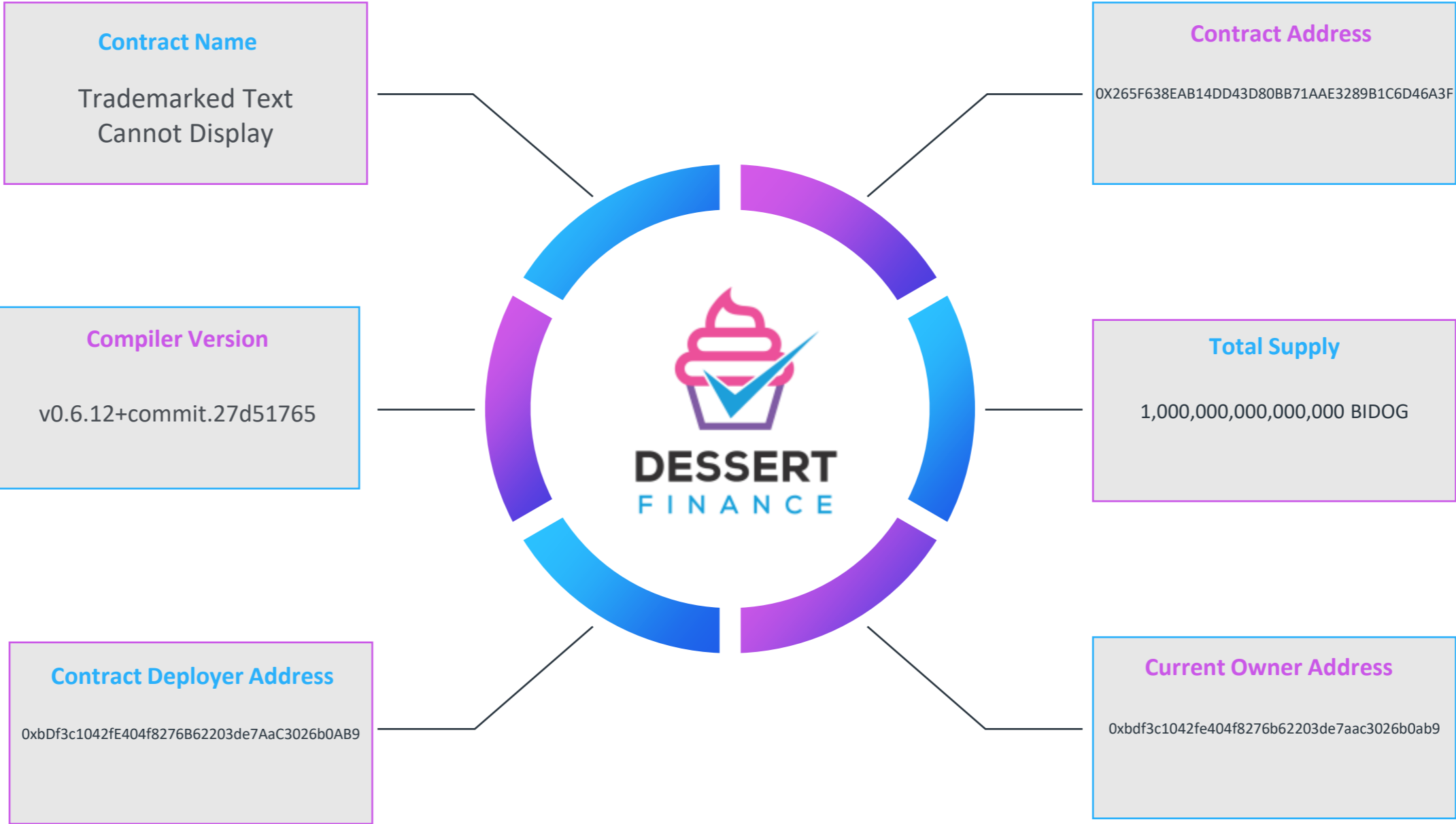

At the time of Audit the transaction fees (“tax”) listed below are the fees associated with trading. These fees are taken from every buy and sell transaction unless otherwise stated.

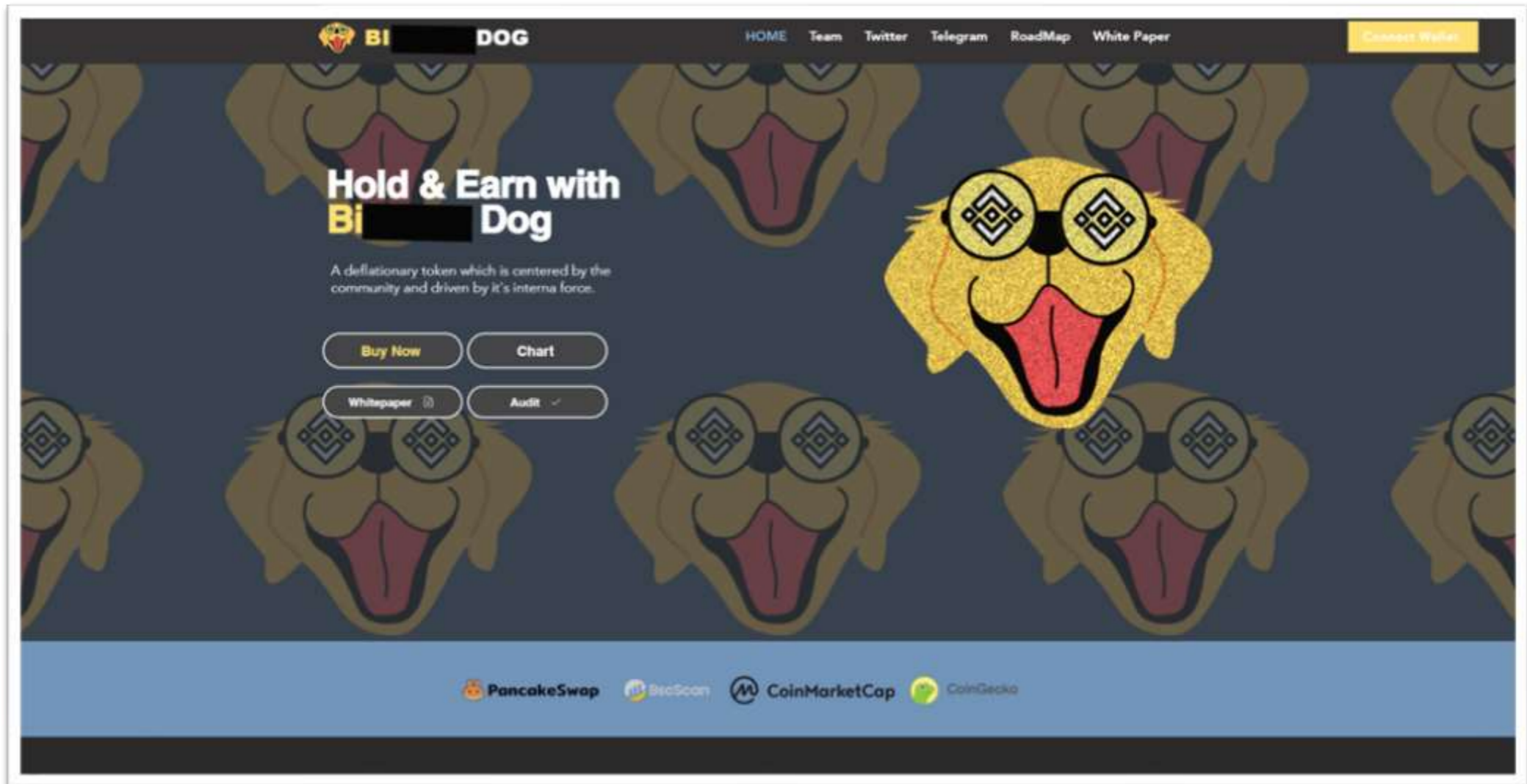
BiDog employs 3 simple functions: Reflection + LP acquisition + Burn. In each trade, the transaction is charged a 10% fee, which is split 2 ways:

Fee per transaction:

- 5% Redistributed to all existing holders.
- 5% fee is split 50/50 half of which is sold by the contract into BNB, while the other half of the BiDog tokens are paired automatically with the previously mentioned BNB and added as a liquidity pair on Pancake Swap.

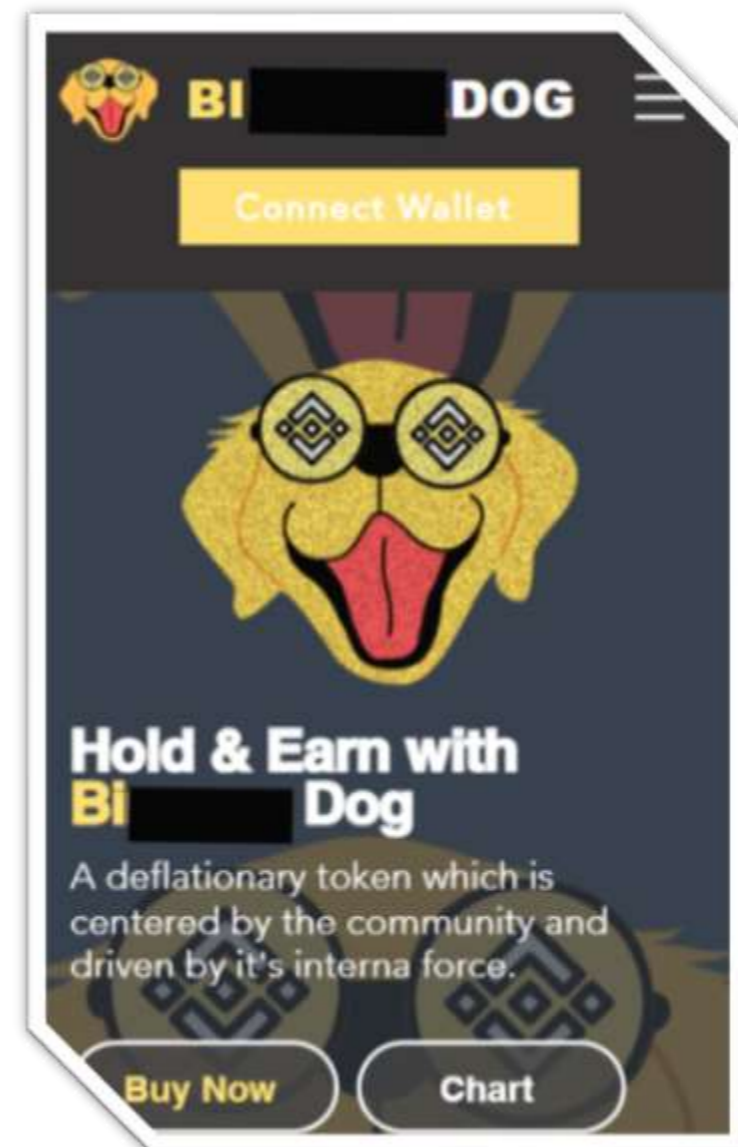
The website contained no JavaScript errors. No typos, or grammatical errors were present, and we found a valid SSL certificate allowing for access via https.

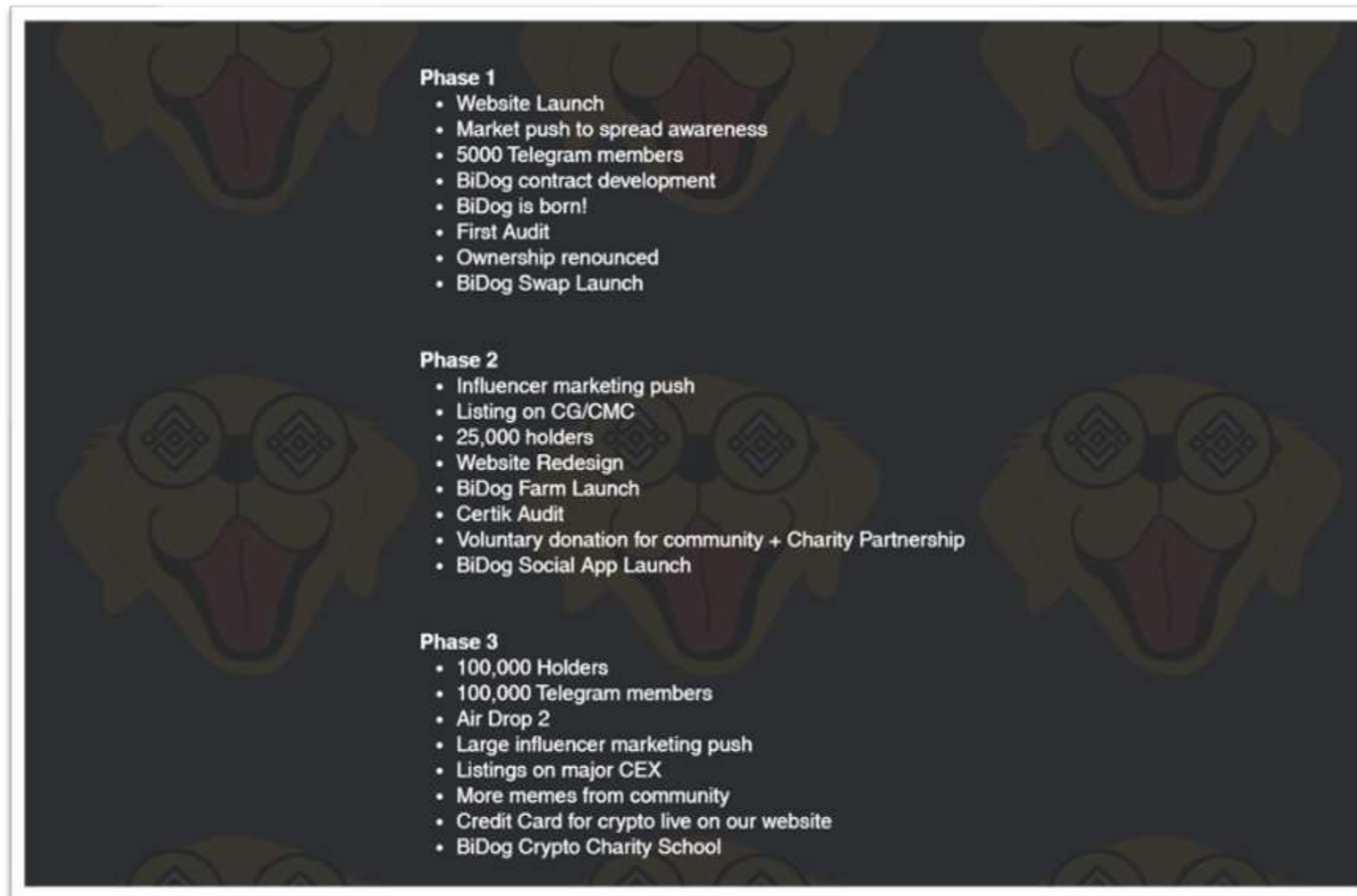
